- 2. Next INABC meeting is schedule for July 16<sup>th</sup> @ 9am virtually.**
- 3. Mari discussed dues changes for companies by size**
- 4. Treasurer Report – Rob Westcott**
  - a. See report provided**
  - b. There has been an increase in membership (larger agencies are getting larger).**
- 5. Secretary report – Kim Adkins**
  - a. Currently 484 members.**
  - b. Membership drive is now over but we continue to have additions occasionally.**
  - c. Secretary is keeping excel document for membership meeting attendance and CEU attendance.**
- 6. Professional Credentialing Committee (PCC) – CJ Gallihugh**
  - a. There are no new RBC applicants.**
- 7. Risk Management – Michelle Webster**
  - a. No issues noted but there is a concern with COVID19 issues.**
  - b. Ex. 1 agency, 2 person setting. 1 vaccinated for COVID, 1 not. Agency not allowing vaccinated person to go into community.**
  - c. Kelly Hartman indicated agencies cannot restrict a person vaccinated to stay home.**
- 8. Ethics committee – Mari Shawcroft**
  - a. No complaints for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2021**
- 9. Partners in Practice – no update; not been able to meet**
- 10. Liaison – Kelly Hartman**
  - a. Appx K has been extended until 6 months after the federal government ends health emergency.**

- i. Telehealth has provided benefits, however, a behavior specialist doesn't get to say no in-person supports (person supported has right to choose another behavior specialist)
- b. BQIS – QOPR(pronounced “copper”) – This is not related to behavior services, but is for residential. This replaces the survey and is based on personal outcomes
  - i. Kelly will send out an INABC email for the Settings Rule
  - ii. Restrictions that are in place without a risk benefit analysis have been noticed and must be addressed. Kelly is going to provide a Rights Responsibilities and Rewards CEU opportunity on April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to assist in clarifying restrictions.

#### **11. Q&A**

- a. If a family requests a BC that is vaccinated, the BC that is not vaccinated does not get to make that decision. BSS has a right not to be vaccinated, but the person/guardian has the right to ask for a vaccinated BC.
- b. Risk vs reward – will be in Power Hour with Kelly Hartman. Always utilize least restrictive first. Kelly will share Insights paragraph for this topic.
- c. Proposal for licensure for BC's in Indiana
  - i. Still need to pursue University of New Hampshire, develop a series of CEUs for Indiana. We would own curriculum and it be an INABC perk. There is an assumption that INABC would have some control.
